



ENTRY FORM

The Lieutenant Governor of British Columbia invites groups to write and sing an original in the lead up to 2021, the 150th anniversary of British Columbia's entry into Confederation.

Criteria:

- An original song written specifically for Sing Me A Song;
- The original song is written and performed collaboratively by a British Columbia-based amateur, community or school group with a minimum of eight voices;
- Songs should be inspired by:
 - What our province, or community means to the participants; or
 - How their community, place or group reflects the values, accomplishments and spirit of the province of British Columbia. This year's theme is inspired by the 150th anniversary of British Columbia's entry into Confederation, taking place in 2021.
- Musical accompaniment is welcome to supplement the voices;
- The song must not exceed five minutes in length;
- Please provide a link to your submission (YouTube is the preferred hosting site) along with a copy of the written lyrics by March 30, 2018. Video files must include at least one visual of the group;
- By submitting the song you grant permission for Government House to post songs and images online and in the media. It is the responsibility of the submitting group to ensure all members of the group have agreed to the terms and conditions in the submission waiver;

Judging Criteria: The songs will be judged on originality, musicality and spirit.

AWARD CATEGORY:

(An award of \$1,000 will be presented in person by the Lieutenant Governor in each of the following categories)

- All members of the group are under the age of 11
- All members of the group are under the age of 18
- Open Category – no age restrictions
